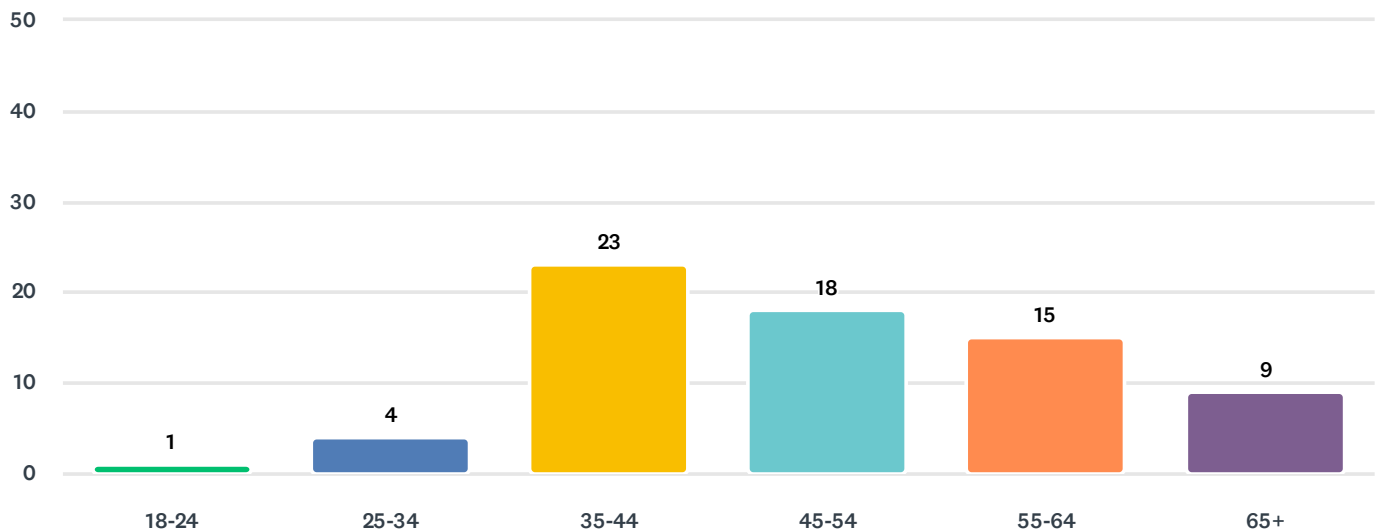

Would you attend a Pasco County Commission on the Status of Women event?



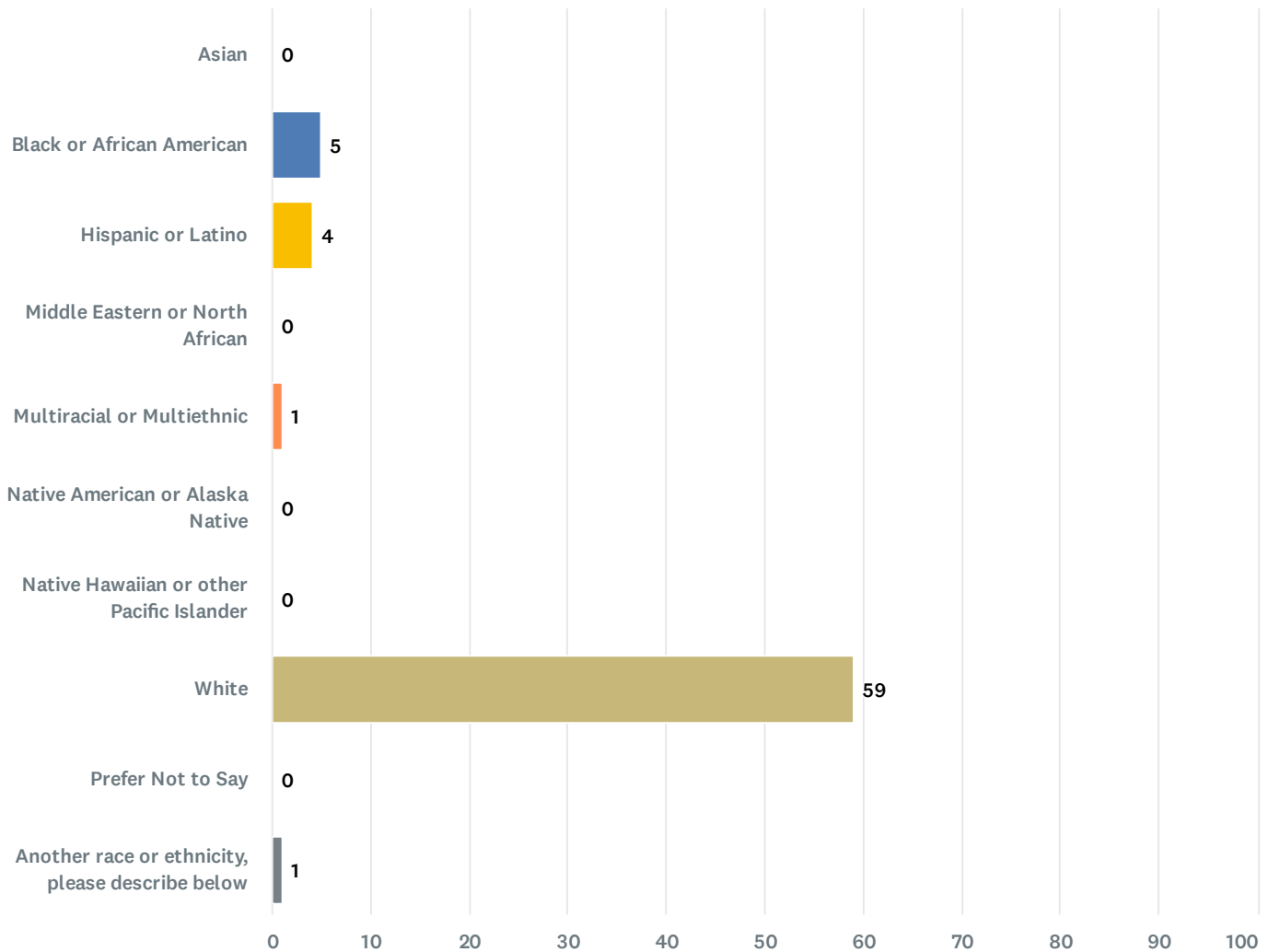

What is your age?



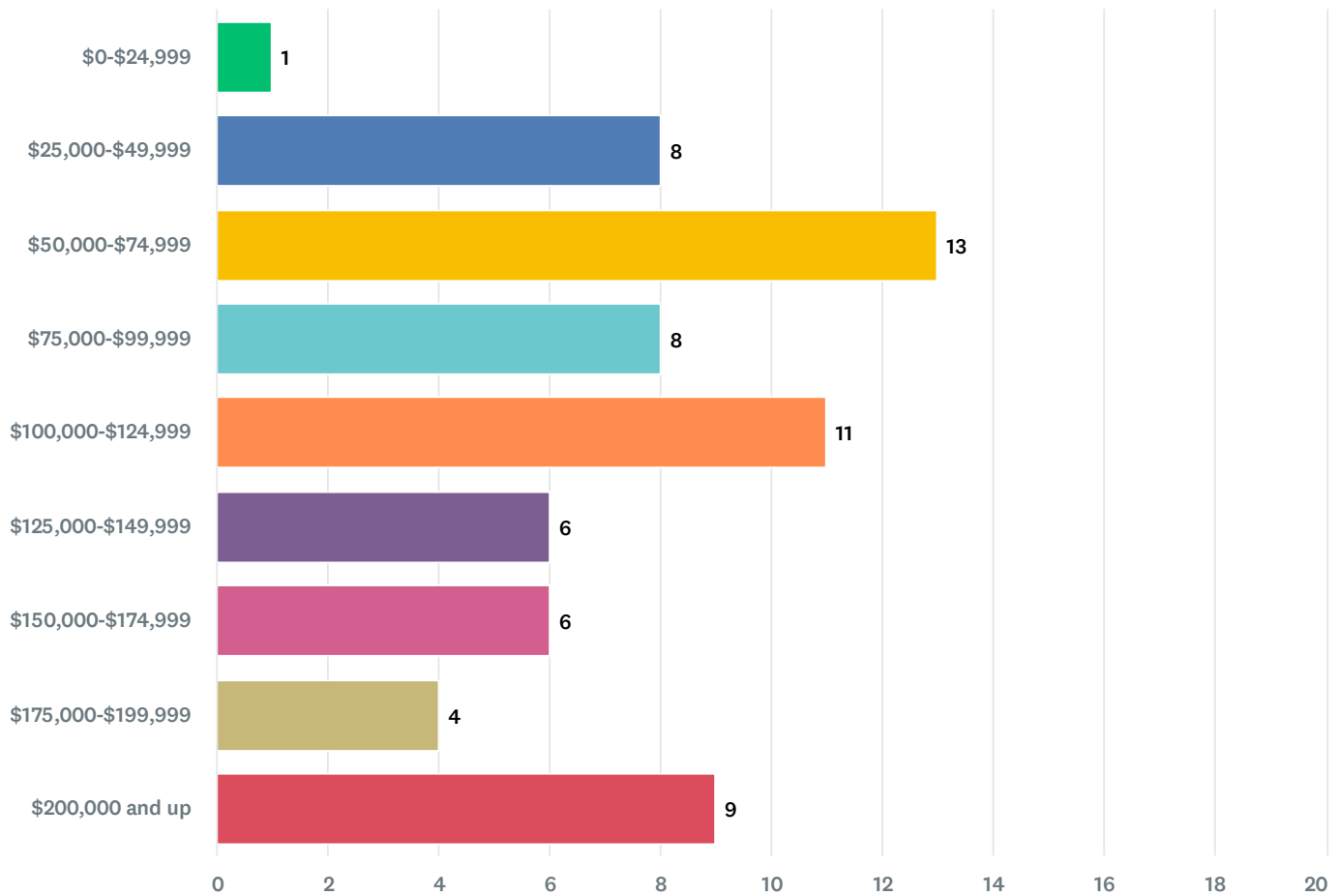

What is your race or ethnicity?

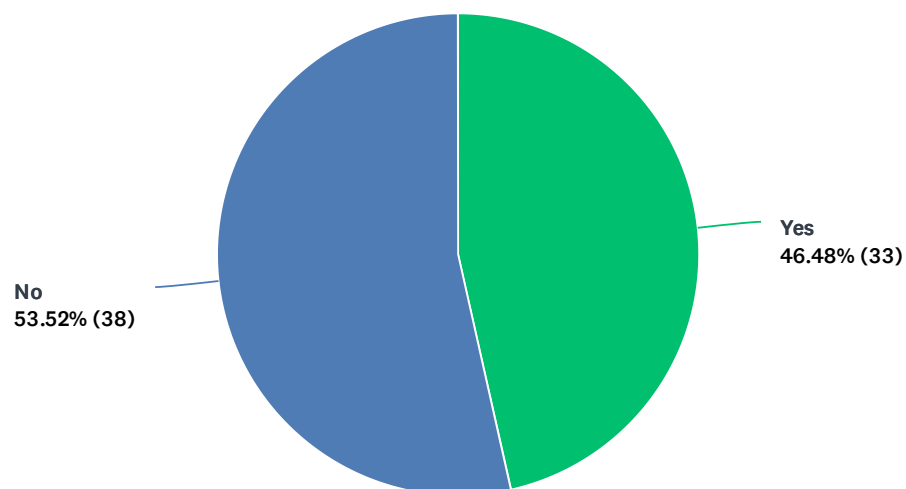

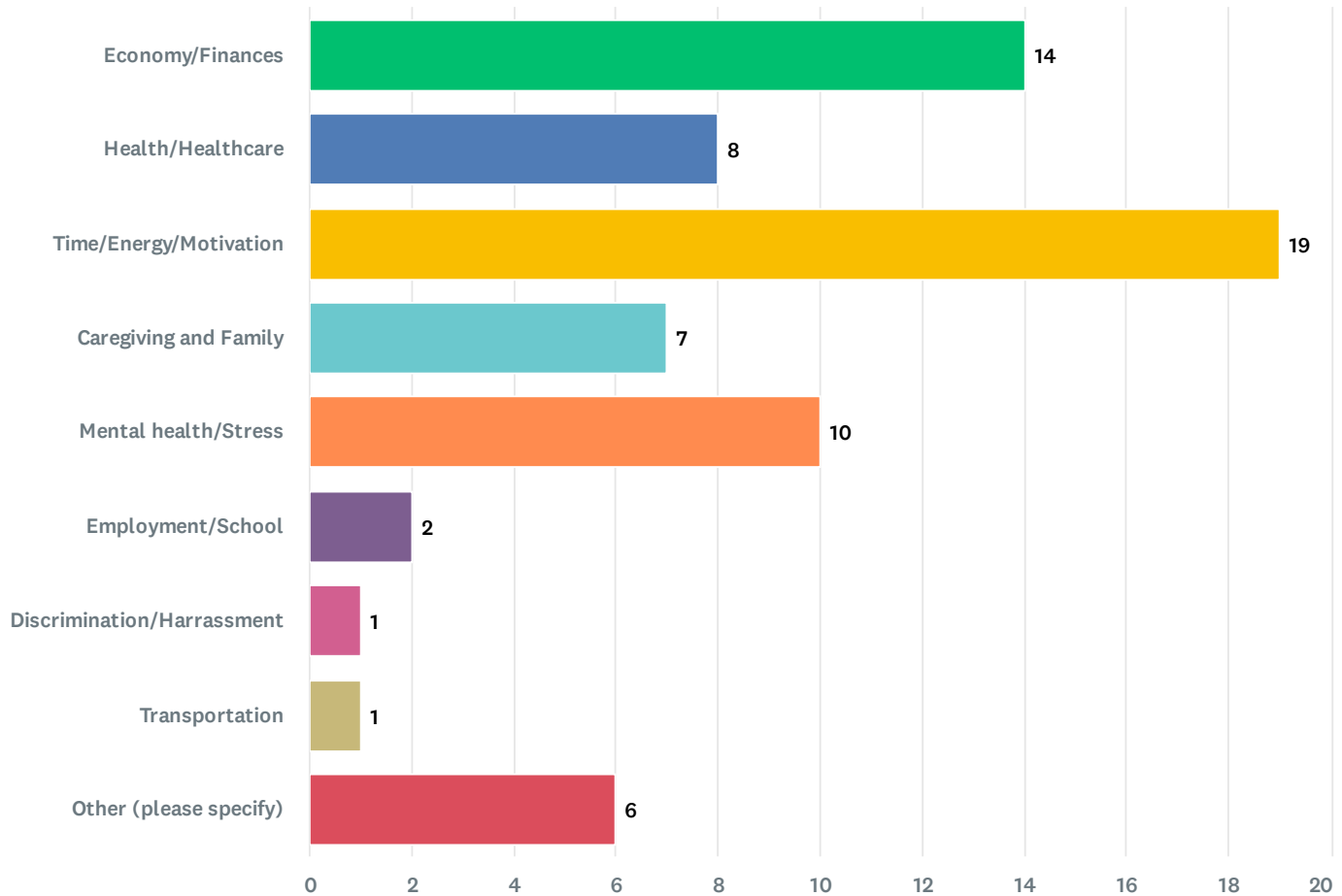

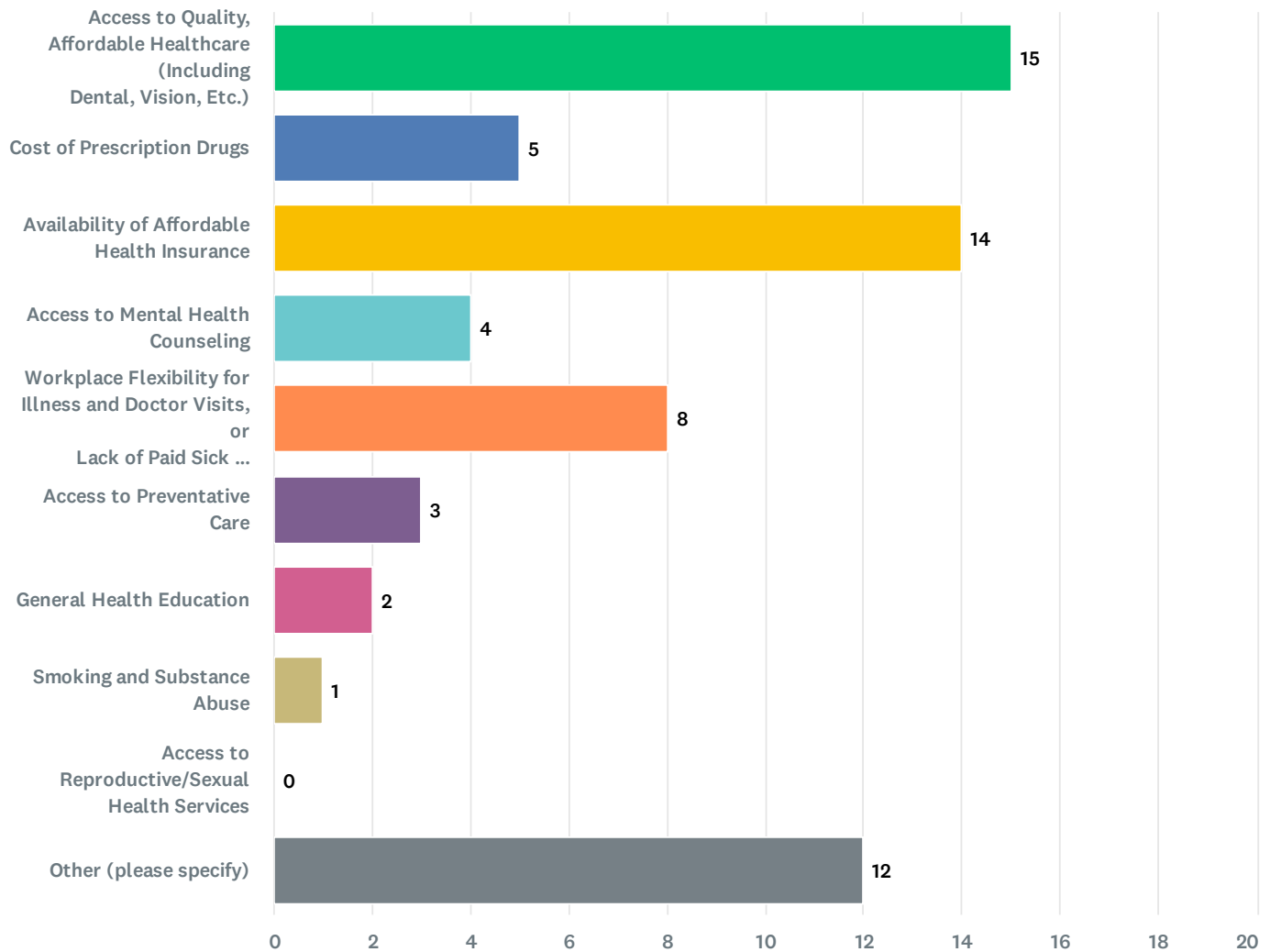
What do you consider to be the most impactful challenge or problem that you face in your daily life?

Which of the following health-related challenges impacts you the most?

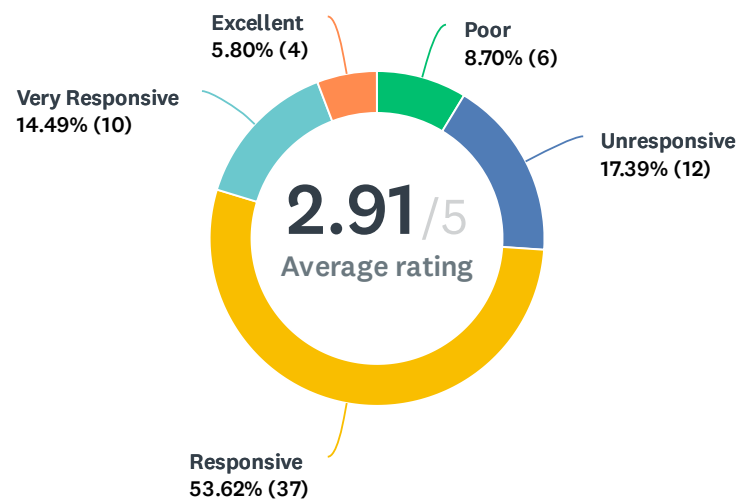

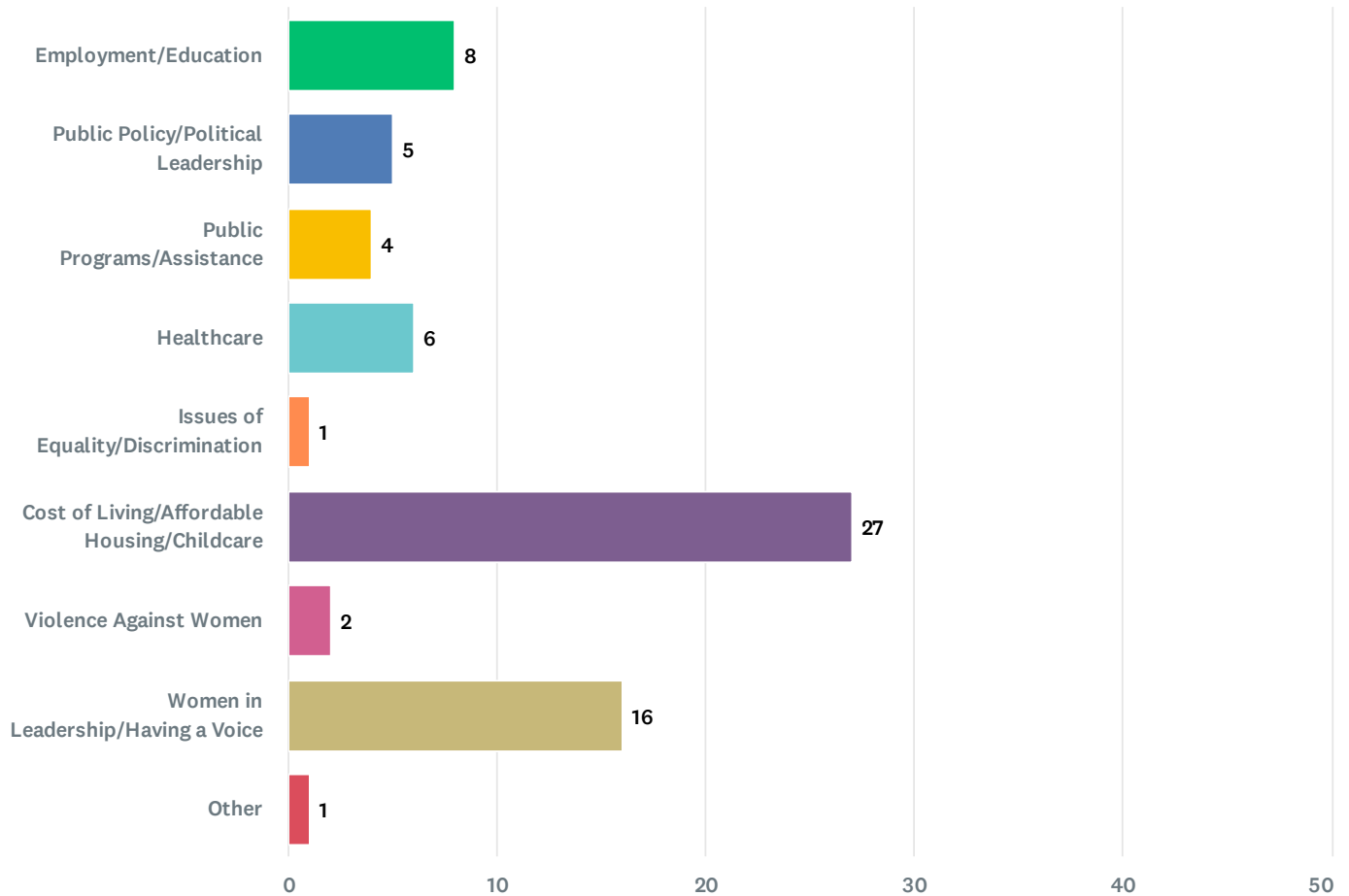

How responsive do you think your local government is to the needs of women in your city or county?



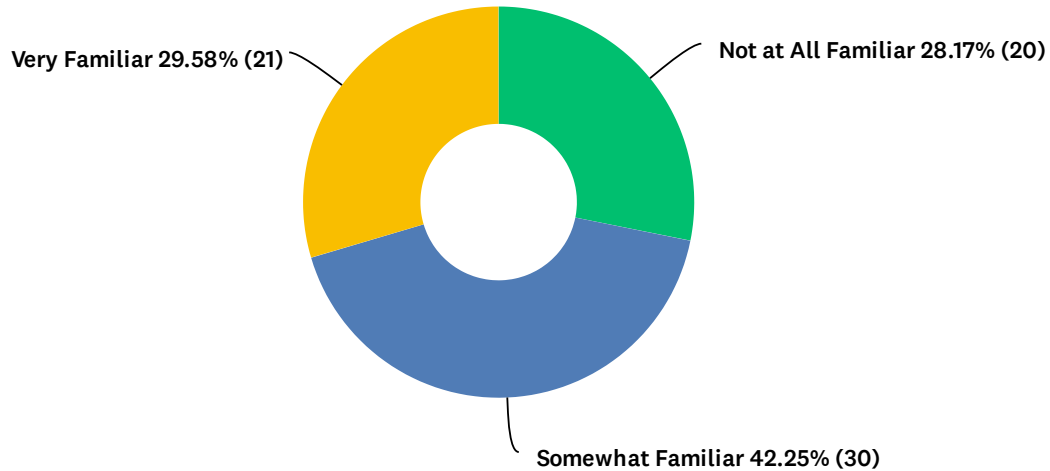

If there was one change that could be made in your community that would result in the greatest positive impact on women, what would it be?



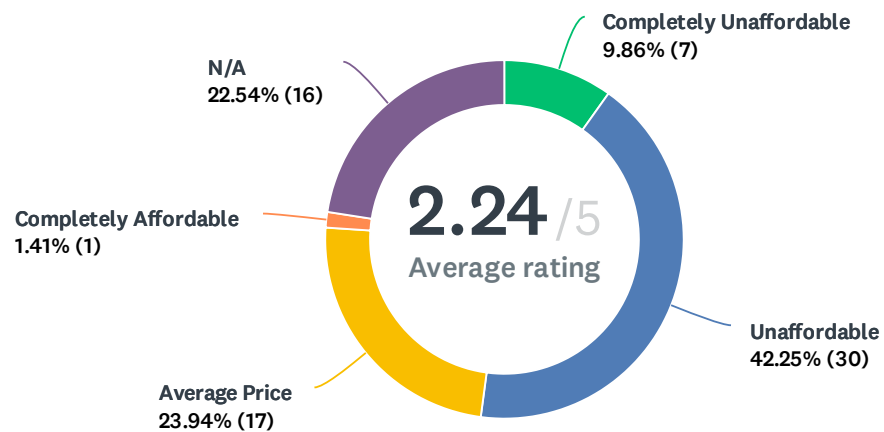
Q15 Prior to today, how familiar were you with the Pasco County Commission on the Status of Women?

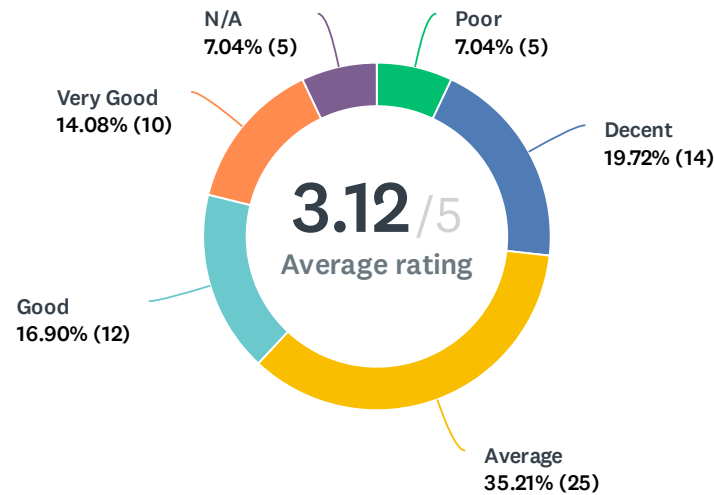

How would you rate the average price of childcare in Pasco County?



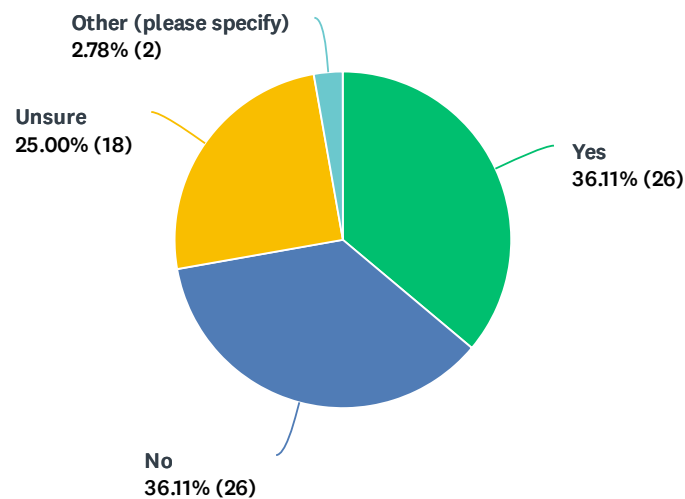

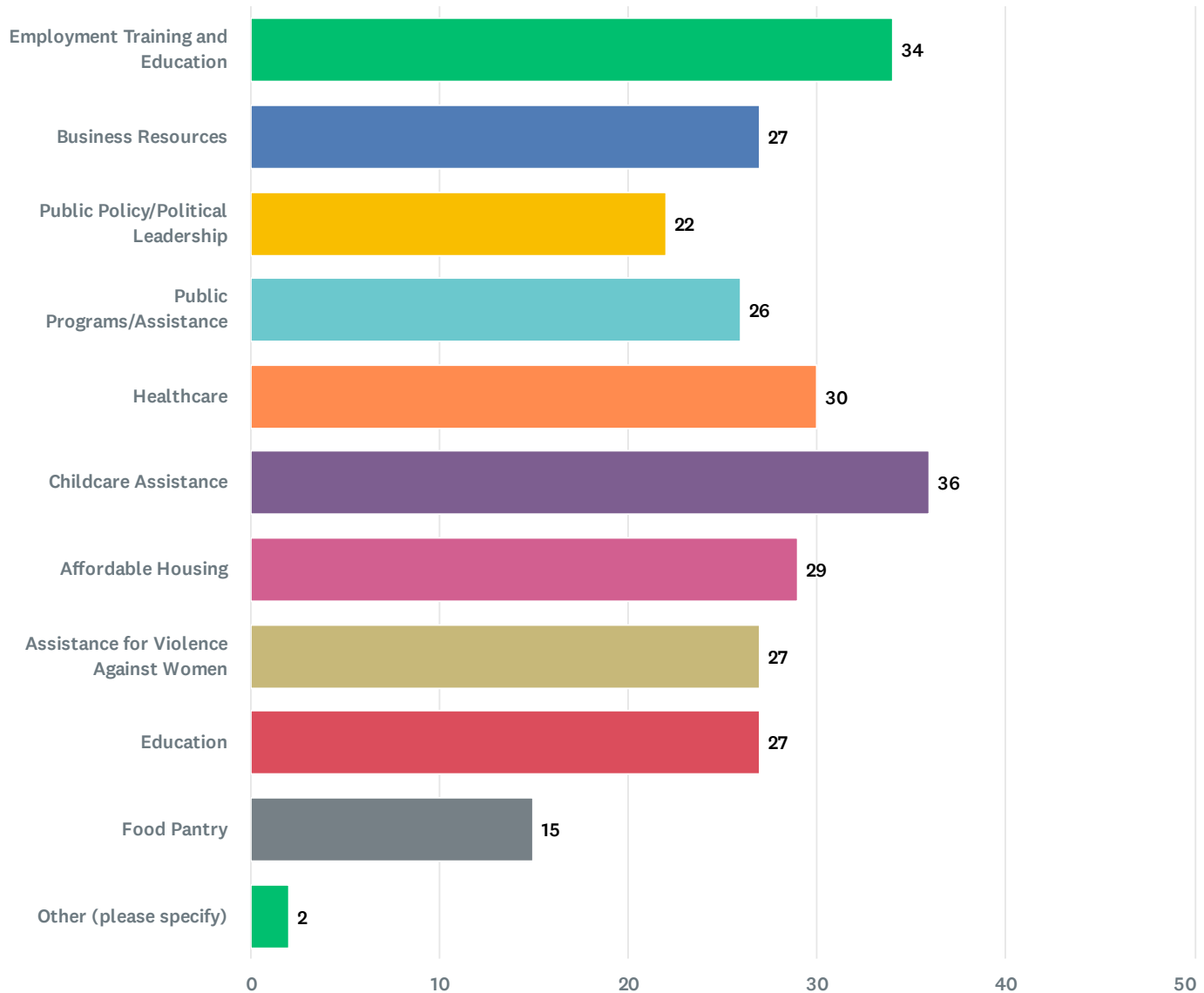
Do you feel women in Pasco County have equal opportunity to leadership roles?

My son's father does not adequately assist financially, I work and I make "too much" (lol like \$42k/yr) for childcare and/or food assistance, but my paycheck just barely covers my bills. And I live modestly in a home I bought pre-pandemic (thank god because my mortgage on my 3bd/2bath home is less than renting a studio or 1bdm apt) and my car is paid off. I am damned if I do and damned if I don't if I am being completely honest. Women like me are stuck in a very difficult position and have very little to no help. And the real kicker is that it seems like my son's father wasn't abusive enough for me to be taken seriously or provided any protections in the Pasco court systems and/or county DV assistance programs/shelters. As if I need to be actively beaten to receive any protection and just the onslaught of verbal, mental, emotional, financial, and past abuse isn't enough.
